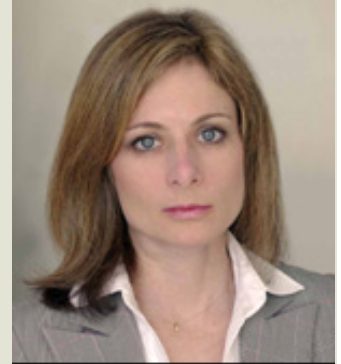




## Concerts for Wednesday, October 25

### Lisa Randall "Warped Passages: Unraveling the Mysteries of the Universe's Hidden Dimensions"



NEC's Presidential Lecture Series welcomes Lisa Randall. Randall studies particle physics and cosmology at Harvard University, where she is professor of theoretical physics. She is a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, a fellow of the American Physical Society, and is a past winner of an Alfred P. Sloan Foundation Research Fellowship, a National Science Foundation Young Investigator Award, a DOE Outstanding Junior Investigator Award, and the Westinghouse Science Talent Search. Randall was featured in *Newsweek's* "Who's Next" January 2006 issue as "one of the most promising theoretical physicists of her generation."
